- Proficient in written and spoken English, and in good health.

This course shares Singapore's approach to protect and manage coastal biodiversity in the face of intense urbanization. It will also discuss the impact of climate change on achieving the Sustainable Development Goals from the aspect of coastal ecosystem services. .
