

FTC also decided that: -

- i. All concerned joint Secretaries will ensure that in future none of the training facilities lapse in any case.
- ii. To increase the nominations especially in Masters/Phd Programs all wings will adopt strong follow up mechanism and repeated reminders/letters will be sent to all concerned before the EAD's dead line other than regular telephonic/email follow up. The concerned desk officer will be liable for strict disciplinary action in case of low response in a particular training facility.
- iii. Concerned Joint Secretaries will hold meetings with their respective donors for improving the mechanism of current training facilities.
- iv. Sr. JS (UN) will make effective coordination among all wings of EAD in order to ensure the receipt of timely and maximum numbers of nomination all over the Pakistan. In this regard meetings on regular basis will held with all Wings in charges/JSs of EAD to improve the current system.
- v. FTC section will not entertain any agenda item or additional item once detailed working paper has been received in FTC section prior to FTC meeting. Moreover, presentation of additional documents during the FTC meeting will be strictly discouraged and concerned desk officer will be held responsible for this.
