3. Moreover, following decisions were also taken in the subject FTC meeting: -
- i. All relevant Federal/Provincial departments such as Universities, Education, Health, Agriculture, Local Government and Livestock, etc be included in the circulation list.
 - ii. Ensure timely updates at EAD's website.
 - iii. Clarify at website that only those foreign trainings are uploaded/circulated by EAD which are in the purview of FTC.
 - iv. In order to ensure timely response, advance copies of the nominations will be considered. In this regard, the following sentence will be added in all circulations: -
"Advance copies of the nominations will be considered subject to finalization after the approval of Competent Authority".
 - v. Regarding the response on the meeting with Provincial Governments, a reminder will be issued under the signatures of AS-I and a meeting will also be convened after 15 days.
