ADMISSION NOTICE FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2016-17

Economic Affairs Division (EAD), Government of Pakistan has been administering Pakistan Technical Assistance Programme (PTAP) since 1976. Under PTAP, a limited number of seats are available in the disciplines of Medicine (MBBS), Dentistry (BDS), Pharmacy (D. Pharmacy) and B.Sc. Engineering for the students of Pakistan Origin having **foreign nationality**, for the Session 2016-17.

2. All those who fulfill the following conditions are eligible to apply:

A) Educational Qualification.

Medicine/Dentistry	English, Chemistry, Biology and Physics or Mathematics.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least 60% marks in HSSC or its equivalent after conversion from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC)• Candidates are required to have passed Entry test of the institution concerned. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In lieu of Entry Test, candidates are required to have passed SAT-II examination with a minimum of “550” score in each of the three subjects, of which two have to be Biology and Chemistry. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• MCAT with a minimum aggregate score of 24. <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In case, medium of instruction is not English in the qualifying examination, then candidates will have to provide a valid TOEFL or IELTS score of 550 or 5.5 respectively. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certification by National University of Modern Languages (NUML), Islamabad after one year English language course.
B. Sc. Engineering	English, Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least 60% marks in HSSC or equivalent examination.• As prescribed by some of the Universities, students are required to have passed SAT-I and SAT-II OR Entry Test.

D. Pharmacy	English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least 60% marks in HSSC or equivalent from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC).

B) General Conditions:

- Must have a valid proof of foreign nationality (self and parent).
- Must have a valid proof of Pak-Origin in the form of Pakistan Origin card/ NADRA I.D. Card or Pakistani Passport.
- Must have studied and passed 12th grade or equivalent exam **physically** from abroad.
- Updated/latest application form which can be downloaded from EAD's website www.ead.gov.pk, should preferably be typed & printed and submitted in **quadruplicate**, along with attested copies of the following documents: -

- HSSC or equivalent certificate alongwith detailed marks certificate/transcripts.
- Equivalence certificate issued by Inter Board Committee of Chairmen, in case of foreign qualification.
- Proof of Foreign Nationality, Self and Parent (foreign passport, citizenship certificate etc.). Green card is not accepted as proof of foreign nationality.
- Proof of Pak-Origin (Pakistani Passport, I.D. Card etc.)
- Result Card of SAT-II or MCAT or Entry Test.
- Valid TOEFL/IELTS score card for admission in B.Sc. Engineering/MBBS/BDS in case medium of instruction is not English.
- Candidates interested to apply against the above seats must submit their complete applications on the prescribed application form (in quadruplicate) in R&I/PTAP Section of Economic Affairs Division along with attachments listed above, not later than **August 31, 2016 for D. Pharmacy & B. Sc. Engineering and October 31, 2016 for MBBS & BDS. Applications received after the cutoff dates will not be entertained.**
