Eligibility Criteria

- Government employees (BS-17 and above) having minimum 10 years working experience and nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid to Senior level government officials who work on issues related to the Law of the Sea and Climate Change.
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio.
- Proficient in spoken and written English.

Objectives

- This course aims provide participants with a summary of climate change impacts on the oceans, as well as how the Law of the Sea (as reflected in UNCLOS) can be used to address them. The limits of UNCLOS in addressing these impacts will also be discussed.
