Subject: Minutes of the Meeting of Foreign Training Committee (FTC) held on 28th April, 2025

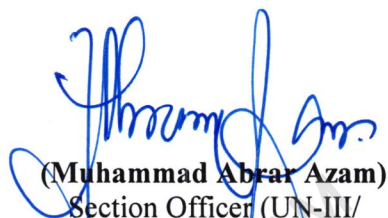
