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About the Organizer	The National Judges College (NJC) is an institution directly affiliated to the Supreme People's Court and a main institution for judicial education and training in China. Founded in 1997, NJC is located at No. 111, West Road of South 4th Ring Road, Huaxiang, Fengtai District, Beijing. It covers an area of 248 mu (about 16.53 hectares) and has a floor area of 65,000 m², with the capacity to train up to 700 participants simultaneously. The college is primarily responsible for providing appointment, reappointment, promotion, and specialized trial-related training for presidents and vice-presidents of China's high people's courts and intermediate people's courts, as well as for senior judges and reserve judicial talents at all levels of the people's courts. It also offers pre-service training for newly appointed judges. In recognition of its performance, the NJC has received commendations from the Supreme People's Court in 2011, 2013, 2014, 2018, 2022, and 2023, and was awarded by the Supreme People's Court a collective third-class merit in 2015. NJC boasts an excellent full-time and part-time faculty, with 27 full-time teachers, including 10 professors, 6 associate professors and 11 lecturers. At the same time, more than 300 part-time teachers are employed from people's courts at all levels, as well as from educational and research institutions and government agencies nationwide. To date, NJC has established 33 branches across China's provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities. NJC serves as a key platform for international exchanges under the Supreme People's Court and functions as "the International Exchange Center for Judges of the Supreme People's Court". In alignment with the Belt and Road Initiative, from 2016 to 2026, NJC has hosted 105 seminars for judges from abroad, training 2480 judicial officials from 92 countries and regions.	
Training content	This seminar aims to implement Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era, deepen practical cooperation between China and Pakistan in the judicial field, enhance Pakistani judges' comprehensive understanding of China's rule of law construction and judicial system, build an important platform for judicial exchanges and cooperation between China and Pakistan, and further consolidate and promote the traditional China-Pakistan friendship. This seminar consists of several parts, including lectures, on-site visits to courts, discussions with judges, and visits to other places. The lecture covers China's national conditions, the legal connotation of Chinese-style modernization, China's court organization and judge system, China's civil and commercial adjudication system, China's criminal adjudication system, China's administrative adjudication system, traditional Chinese culture, etc., which is helpful for the trainees to understand the socialist legal system with Chinese characteristics. The keynote speakers will include senior judges from various divisions of the Supreme People's Court, the President, Vice President, and professors of the NJC as well as law professors from well-known universities. The seminar will include visits to primary people's courts, where participants can engage in discussions with judges to gain insights into China's judicial procedures and system. Participants will also go on field trips to other cities, which include visiting local courts for discussions, touring cultural heritage sites and enterprises, and visiting specialized courts for thematic exchanges. Please note that the above is a preliminary schedule. The cities to be visited may be adjusted according to the actual situation. The final version will be provided upon participants' arrival in China.
