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About the Organizer	Free Trade Development Board of Zhejiang Province (Secretariat of China Center for Cooperation on Special Economic Zones in BRICS Countries), formerly known as the Training Center of Department of Commerce of Zhejiang Province, is a public institution affiliated with the Department of Commerce of Zhejiang Province. It is responsible for the construction of China Center for Cooperation on Special Economic Zones in BRICS Countries, the development of the China (Zhejiang) Pilot Free Trade Zone, as well as the training of the provincial commerce system and the certification of business talents. Since undertaking foreign aid training programs in 2012, the Board has organized a total of 109 training sessions, covering a total of 3265 participants from 99 countries and 2 international organizations. Training topics include digital economy, green sustainable development, development of free trade zone and open platform, international economic and business cooperation, business related themes, human resource management, tourism and hotel management, sports development, etc. Participants include government officials and technical personnel at various levels. 3. Field Visits:

(1) Visit leading digital economy enterprises including Alibaba, enterprises of the “Six Little Dragons of Hangzhou”, Hikvision and Dahua Technology in Hangzhou Future Science and Technology City, Binjiang High-tech Zone to learn about their innovative practices and development models in e-commerce platform operation, cloud computing, big data, and large AI models.

(2) Visit the zero carbon demonstration park in Moganshan High-tech Zone of Huzhou to inspect facilities such as the energy center, green factories and intelligent management and control platforms within the park.

(3) Visit the green supply chain and digital logistics demonstration projects at Ningbo Zhoushan Port, to study how the port applies digital technologies to realize intelligent scheduling of cargo transportation, real-time tracking and sharing of logistics information, as well as new measures for building a green port.

(4) Visit the near zero carbon park at Jiaxing Chengdong Wetland Park in Jiaxing, Zhejiang Province, to inspect the demonstration project of the photovoltaic, energy storage, direct current and flexibility (PEDF) smart energy system and innovative achievements in the low-carbon digital renovation of buildings
