### **Course Objective:**

The main theme of the program is "**Countering Cybercrime and Crimes involving the Misuse of Crypto-Asset**". The participants will gain an understanding of international legal frameworks on cybercrime and the misuse of crypto Assets. The administration of criminal justice will be improved by referring to the latest international trends, as well as best policies and practices.

### **Eligibility Criteria:-**

The applicant should:

- Be an officer dealing with criminal justice such as investigators, public prosecutors, judges and members of the specialized organization. Members of legislative bodies and public officials from policy-making bodies research institutions, and criminal justice organization in charge of measures against Cyber crimes and crime involving the misuse of crypto assets are also acceptable on the condition that they have sufficient knowledge of criminal procedures, in particular, those of investigation and trial.
- Be university graduates or the equivalent thereof;
- Have at least 05 years of practical experience in the relevant field.
- Have command of spoken and written English
- Be under (50) years of age.
- The women Candidates are encouraging to apply.


