- Identifying the challenges in formulating and implementing a comprehensive legal framework in the aspects of climate change, marine pollution, IUU fishing, marine technology maritime security and the law of the Sea.
- Assessing the best practices of the respective countries on formulating maritime legal framework and policies.
- Formulating strategic action plans to enhance legal framework that are aligned with the respective countries policies and agenda.
