ADMISSION NOTICE FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-20

Under Pakistan Technical Assistance Programme (PTAP), a limited number of seats are available in the disciplines of Medicine (MBBS), Dentistry (BDS), Pharmacy (D. Pharmacy) and B.Sc. Engineering for the students of Pakistan Origin having **foreign nationality**, for the Session 2019-20.

2. All those who fulfill the following conditions are eligible to apply:

A) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

Discipline	No. of Seats	Subjects	Score
MBBS & BDS	20 MBBS 02 BDS	Chemistry, Biology and Physics or Mathematics.	1) At least 70% marks in HSSC or its equivalent after conversion from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC). 2) Candidates are required to have secured at least 60% marks in Entry Test. OR In lieu of the Entry Test, candidates are required to have passed SAT-II examination with a minimum of "550" marks in each of the three subjects, of which two have to be biology and chemistry. OR A foreign MCAT with a minimum score of 500. 3) In case, medium of instruction is not English in the qualifying examination, then candidates will have to provide a valid TOEFL or IELTS score of 550 or 5.5 respectively. OR Certification by National University of Modern Languages (NUML), Islamabad after one year English language course.
B. Sc. Engineering	13 Engg.	Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics.	1) At least 60% marks in HSSC or equivalent examination. 2) As prescribed by some of the Universities, candidates are required to have passed SAT-I and SAT-II OR Entry Test. 3) In case, medium of instruction is not English in the qualifying examination, then candidates will have to provide a valid TOEFL or IELTS score of 550 or 5.5 respectively. OR Certification by National University of Modern Languages (NUML), Islamabad after one year English language course.
D. Pharmacy	02 Pharmacy	Physics, Chemistry & Biology.	At least 60% marks in HSSC or equivalent from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC).

B) GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. Must have a valid proof of foreign nationality (self and parent).
 2. Must have a valid proof of Pak-Origin in the form of Pakistan Origin card/ NADRA I.D. Card or Pakistani Passport.
 3. Must have studied and passed 12th grade or equivalent exam **physically** from abroad.
3. Updated/latest application form which can be downloaded from EAD's website www.ead.gov.pk, should preferably be typed & printed and submitted in **quadruplicate**, along with attested copies of the following documents: -
1. HSSC or equivalent certificate alongwith detailed marks certificate/transcripts.
 2. Equivalence certificate issued by Inter Board Committee of Chairmen, in case of foreign qualification.
 3. Proof of Foreign Nationality, Self and Parent (foreign passport, citizenship certificate etc.). Green card is not accepted as proof of foreign nationality.
 4. Proof of Pak-Origin (Pakistani Passport, I.D. Card etc.)
 5. Result Card of SAT-II or MCAT or Entry Test.
 6. Valid TOEFL/IELTS score card for admission in B.Sc. Engineering/MBBS/BDS in case medium of instruction is not English.
4. Candidates interested to apply against the above seats must submit their complete applications on the prescribed application form (in quadruplicate) in R&I/PTAP Section of Economic Affairs Division along with attachments listed above, not later than **September 10, 2019** for **D. Pharmacy & B. Sc. Engineering** and **October 10, 2019** for **MBBS & BDS**. **Incomplete applications or applications received after the set deadlines will not be entertained.**
