- Be a high-ranking officer who belongs to National Police, Ministry of Interior or intelligence service in charge of counter terrorism or terrorism investigation assuming a position of Director or above.
- Be university graduates or the equivalent thereof;
- Have command of spoken and written English
- Have basic computer skills.
- Must be in good health.
