Course Objective:

To strengthen the health policy formulation and the implementation and service provision capacity in the government or academic/ health institutions and other relevant organizations to contribute to attain Universal Health Coverage (UHC) in respective partner countries and to build and strengthen strategic partnership between partner countries and Japan.

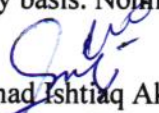
Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicants should:-

- Be young or mid-career government officer, prospective academics to contribute policy formulation or its implementation for tackling sustainable developmental issues related to UHC.
- For master program be a holder of a bachelor's or a higher Degree.
- Have command of spoken and written English.
- Be under age of 40 years.
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply for this program.

Furthermore, the concerned officer may be directed to submit **Post-Visit Training Report** to this Ministry on priority basis. Nomination of contractual employees will not be entertained.
