2 The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

The preferred international learners must possess the following minimum eligibility standards:

- General Certificate of Education (GCE) A-Level or equivalent with at least 1-year minimum experience in financial/banking services industry.
- Must demonstrate a good command of spoken English;
- High-speed internet access with speed requirement at least 1.5Mbps; and
- An appropriate device including audio and video capacity (computer or laptop and smartphone or high-end tablet.).

Objective

The 5-day training programme will emphasize on Islamic and the relevance and importance of sustainable practices in the post pandemic era. The programme will provide an overview of how Islamic finance supports environmental sustainability and contribute towards addressing socio-economic challenges. Islamic finance and Sustainability (ISUSTAIN) is designed to enable participants to;

- Appreciate the individual roles and responsibilities as a steward on earth;
- Understand the role of Islamic finance towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals; and
- Analyse and evaluate best sustainability practices in the financial sector.
