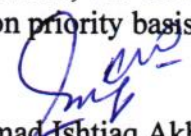
Eligibility Criteria: -

- Be in a nursing position or its supervising position to be responsible for planning, implementation, evaluating and managing of maternal and child health in the government which address to improve public health
- Have working experience in the relevant field.
- Have command of spoken and written of English
- Be Between the age of 20 and 35 years.
- Must be in good health
- Women are encouraged to apply for the program
