Eligibility Criteria


The preferred international participants must possess the following eligibility standards;

- Government Officers (BS-17 and above) nominated by their respective Federal and Provincial Governments.
- Managers/Officers from Banking Industries, Shariah advisers/Financial Advisers/Consultants, Accountants, Auditor and Compliance Officers;
- Must demonstrate a good command of English- written and spoken.
- Age between 26-50 years and had never participated in any MTCP programme;
- An appropriate device (computer or laptop and smartphone or high-end table).
- Certified medically fit; and
- Fully Vaccinated.

Objective

AQIF aim to provide learners with the right knowledge that is vital understand the basics of Islamic finance. It is designed to assist learners with the following objectives;

- Explain the meaning of Shariah, its objectives and sources;
- Describe and identify the applications of Islamic finance transaction;
- Identify the principles of ethics;
- Identify the implementation of ethical values in Islamic finance; and
- Discuss the and challenges on implementing Shariah Governance.
