The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited 1 (one) nomination for the above training course. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

**Eligibility Criteria**

- Government employees (BS-17 and above) having minimum 10 years working experience and nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid to Senior level government officials who are involved in policymaking related to (i) Climate Change, (ii) Green Finance projects and related fields.
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio.
- Proficient in spoken and written English.

**Objectives**

- Climate Change is a complex global challenge that needs collective action. Climate Finance, a subset of Green Finance, plays transition towards a low-carbon future. It refers to financial resources and initiatives that seek to support mitigation and adaption measures to tackle the challenges of climate change.
- As part of Singapore efforts to do our part to build a sustainable future, the Singapore Green Plan 2030 was launched and the Singapore Government has taken active steps to drive long-term effective climate action, involving multiple stakeholders from financial institution to non-financial partners.
- The programme aims to discuss the financing mechanisms available to support climate change projects as well as to share Singapore active measures to build a climate resilient future.
