- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio.
- Proficient in spoken and written English.

Objectives

- This course will cover the environmental challenges arising from climate change, and Singapore adaptation and mitigation strategies to address them.


