OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: SEMINAR ON ANTI-TERRORISM FOR PAKISTAN UNDER CHINA AID FROM 02ND TO 16TH NOVEMBER, 2023 (15 SLOTS)

The undersigned is directed to state that Government of People's Republic of China has offered fully funded subject seminar for the officers of Government of Pakistan. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable for any cost. The requisite qualification and general requirements are as under:-

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Officers (**BS-17 & above**) of Ministries / Divisions / Attached Departments and Provincial Governments most relevant to the training programmes.
- Proficiency in English.
- Contract employees are not eligible.

2. Documents Required

The following documents (**02 sets of each**) are required to be sent alongwith the nomination:

- Application Form
- Information Form duly filled in by the nominee.
- FTC Proforma.
- Copy of CNIC
- Copy of Passport at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages
- Medical Certificate (Foreigner Physical Examination Form)
- Surety Bond
- Undertaking
- Copy of Covid-19 Full Vaccination Certificate
- No criminal record certificate attested by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan.

3. Nominations of suitable candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria duly approved by the competent authority may be forwarded to this Ministry by 04th September, 2023 positively. Following points must be considered while nominating the candidates:

- a. Most relevant candidates should be nominated for the subject training programmes.
- b. Nomination of candidates should reach EAD before the deadline. Late arrival of nomination after the EADs' deadline will not be entertained.
- c. Nomination papers complete in all respect may be forwarded to EAD through proper channel i.e. through their respective Administrative Ministry / Division/ P&D Department.

Trainee requirements	Age	Trainees holding a director-general position must be no older than 50 years of age, and those holding a director position must be no older than 45 years of age.	
	Health condition	Trainees must be in good health, and must provide a health certificate or physical examination form issued by a local public hospital. They should not have any diseases prohibited by Chinese laws and regulations for entry, nor have serious chronic diseases such as severe hypertension, cardiovascular and cerebrovascular diseases, diabetes, etc., or mental illnesses or infectious diseases that may pose a significant threat to public health. They should not be in the recovery period after major surgery or in the acute phase of an illness, nor have severe physical disabilities or be pregnant.	
	Linguistic competence	Trainees' listening, speaking, reading, and writing abilities in English should meet the requirements for attending lectures and participating in discussions.	
	Other	Participants coming to China for training are not allowed to bring their spouse or relatives.
