SUBJECT: CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT TOWARDS AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT

November 18, 2026 to December 16, 2026 in Japan**. Course Objectives

The Program aims to contribute to the improvement of the air quality management in participating countries especially by strengthening capacities to develop policies and measures for air pollution control and introducing air quality management tools such as air quality monitoring, emission inventory and dispersion modeling.

Eligibility Criteria

The applicants should:

- Be technical officer responsible for air quality management and air pollution control in research institute, public organization
- Have 3 years of professional experience in the field.
- Be a graduate of university.
- Proficient in spoken and written English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally.
- Women are encouraged to apply for the program.

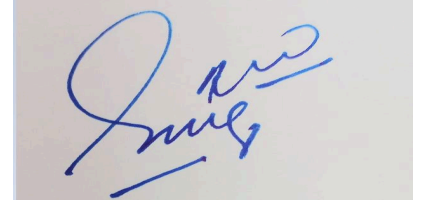
