Course Objective:

Participants will be able to understand the Okinawa's water resource management system to improve their ability of managing the water resource, water works and non-revenue water and utilize practically the theory and technology of small-scale water purification system in Slow Sand Filtration (EPS).

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be an officer engaged in Water **Supply Services**.
- Have experience in the field of water supply services is highly desirable.
- Be university graduates preferably majored in water engineering.
- Be between the ages of twenty-five (25) and fifty (50) years.
- Have command of spoken and written English.
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply for the course.

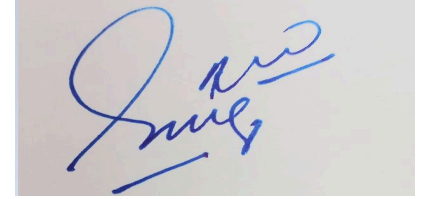
