Course Objective:

Overview of Japan 's aquaculture and its development plan/ public organization structure, tourism/aquaculture development strategies promoted by public- Private sector in Japan; aquaculture and seed production techniques and to plan effective measures to develop the aquaculture industry and to improve the current aquaculture/ seed production in KPK Province.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Only nominations will be considered which are relevant to the project
- Who working and relate to trout culture development in KP province and related with JICA ongoing Technical Cooperation Project on Cold and Warm Inland Aquaculture
- Have more than 5 years' working experience in the field.
- Be a graduate of university or equivalent, specialized in civil engineering
- Have command of spoken and written English
- Have basic computer skills such as sending / receiving email with attachments and using a web browser.
- Be between the ages of 25 and 40 years in principle
- Must be in good health.
