Course Objective:

This program aims to develop human resources who understand necessary organizations, functions, technologies, process and human resources for cyber security incident response, particularly against advanced persistent threat (APT), through lectures on recent cyber security measures and incident handling exercises.

Eligibility Criteria:-

The applicants should:-

- Currently be a cyber incident management specialist on a governmental CSIRT (Computer Security Incident Response Team) or working in ICT system administration department
- Have basic knowledge of cyber security terminology and basic skills for server and network operations
- Be graduate of university, or equivalent
- Have a competent command of spoken & written English.
- Be between the age of twenty-five (25) and fifty (50) years
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally, to participate in the program.
- Women are encouraged to apply for the program
