SUBJECT: DAM SAFETY MANAGEMENT

The undersigned is directed to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency has offered fully funded **one seat** for the subject training Program scheduled to be held **w.e.f November 23, 2026 to December 12, 2026 in Japan**. All concerned Ministries / Divisions / Departments are requested to send nomination of suitable officers along with three (3) copies of prescribed JICA application form, surety bond, undertaking, CNIC, Passport and FTC Performa as advised in [GI booklet](#) , latest by **15-09-2026**.

Course Objective:

To strengthen practical skills for dam management and operation as well as formulating policies and measures to ensure the safety and upgrade the function of dams.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be officers in-charge involved in the field of dam management, operation and maintenance, in particular large dams, and dam related infrastructure, and river basin management. Preferably, from mid-career professionals making policies for dam safety management in the future.
- Have more than 3 years' experience in dam management, in particular large dams, water resource management and water related disaster risk reduction.
- Be university graduate or equivalent.
- Be under age of 50 years.
- Women are encouraged to apply for the program

2. New prescribed JICA's Application forms along and specimen of surety bond, undertaking and FTC Performa can be downloaded from EAD's website www.ead.gov.pk under "Foreign Trainings" link in "Forms" ad also available on JICA's website www.jica.go.jp/pakistan/english/index.html.

3. In case of selection of the officer the concerned Ministries/Division/Department are requested to ensure timely relieving of the officer along with NoC. Furthermore, the concerned officer may be directed to submit **Post-Visit Training Report** to this Ministry on priority basis.

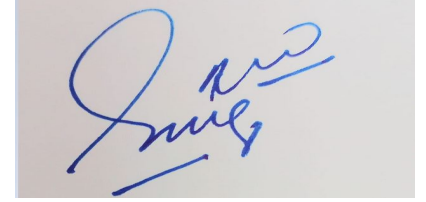
