SUBJECT: FOOD SAFETY, HYGIENE AND QUALITY CONTROL IN SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT OF MILK, MEAT AND EGGS.

The undersigned is directed to inform that Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has offered fully funded **one** seat on the subject training program scheduled to be held **w.e.f February 15, 2027 to April 22, 2027 in Japan**. All concerned Ministries / Divisions / Departments are requested to send nomination of suitable officer who fulfills the criteria to the undersigned by **01-11-2026** along with three (3) copies of prescribed JICA forms, CNIC, Passport, FTC Performa, undertaking & surety bond and Inception Report as advised in the G.I. Booklet.

Course Objective: -

To develop human resources who understand the mechanisms and techniques on hygiene and quality control in production, processing and distribution processes (Farm to table) of foods of animal origin and contribute to the supply system development for those foods through one health approach.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicants should: -

- Be Government food inspection supervisors and planning officers in livestock quality control/marketing, Production, processing and distribution of foods of animal origin.
- Have more than three (03) years' work experience in relevant fields
- Have Bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- Be proficient in spoken and written English
- Be under age of 45 years.
- Women are encouraged to apply for the program

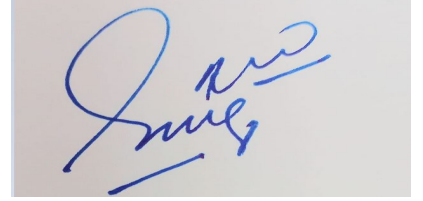
