- Has never participated in any MTCP courses.
- Proficient in English language, and medically fit.
- Be equipped with the relevant ICT tools such as laptop/desktop, web camera, microphone, speaker etc. & familiar with online learning platforms like Zoom, Google Meet etc.

**Objective**

- Gain an in-depth understanding on the mechanisms, tools, focus areas and challenges in developing functional and sustainable cities.
- Comprehend the central role of public space transformation in shaping perceptions and empowering communities.
- Develop problem-solving skills in challenging areas to provide for a much sustainable and workable solutions and strategies.
- Be able to analyse or recommend an urban revitalization and identify the criteria for determining the success of that strategy.
