Course Objective:

To formulate an action plan on planning and designing of the electric power system that can accommodate large amounts of VRE by understanding the characteristics of VRE and electric power system

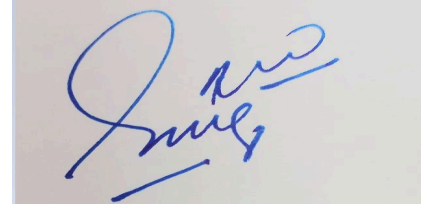
Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicants should: -

- Be Electrical engineers in charge of planning/designing electric power systems (transmission and substation facilities) in government ministries or agencies in charge of electric power management.
- Have more than 5 years working experience in the field of electric power transmission, transformation or distribution.
- Be a bachelor's degree in engineering or equivalent
- Be between the age of thirty-five (25) and forty (45) years
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally, to participate in the program in Japan.
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply for this program.

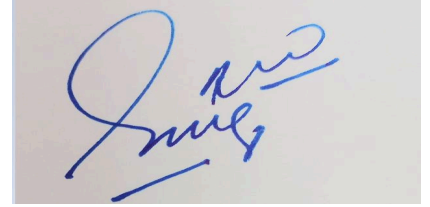
