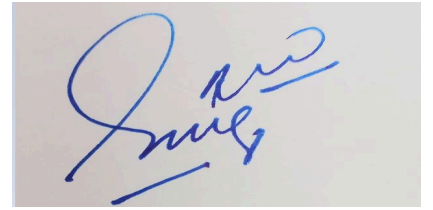
Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be in-charge of observation and management of hydrological data.
- Have Several years' practical experience as an administrator in the field of river/water resources management including hydrological observation.
- Be university graduates or equivalent.
- Be between age of 25 and 45 years.
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply for this program.

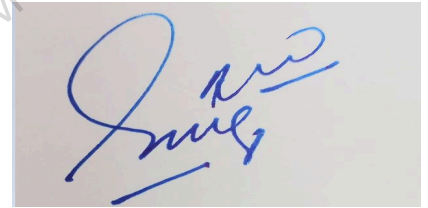
