- Not be applicant from researchers at research institutes or organizations.
- Have been in the office for more than 06 years, including the experience of forest management for more than 03 years.
- Be a graduate of university or equivalent.
- Have command of spoken and written English
- Be under the forty-nine (49) years of age.
- Must be in good health.
