Eligibility Criteria: -

- Be permanent government employee (BS-17 or above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials involved in policymaking for sustainability and
- the environment;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health..

Objective: -

- This course will explore how nations can implement the comprehensive requirements of Article 6 of the Paris Agreement effectively and realistically.
