OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: TRAINING COURSE ON FINTECH GOVERNANCE BUILDING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE OF FINANCE TO BE CONDUCTED IN DOHA QATAR FROM 18 TO 22 OCTOBER 2026, UNDER THE SINGAPORE QATAR ASIA MIDDLE EAST DIALOGUE AMED TRAINING PROGRAMME.

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited nominations for the above **Partially Funded** training course. The Governments of Singapore and Qatar will bear the participants' round-trip economy class airfare and course fees, including trainers' fees, course materials and training venue. **However, the cost of accommodation, and other local and incidental costs for the participants would be borne by the nominating agency/nominee himself/herself and as insurance will not be provided, participants are strongly advised to purchase comprehensive travel insurance which includes medical evacuation in the event of any unexpected emergencies.** The brochure of the subject training course is available at www.ead.gov.pk

2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria: -

- Be permanent government employee (BS-17 or above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials who are involved in fintech governance;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.
- Prepared to participate actively in the programme.

Objective:-

- This course will equip participants with insights on the latest developments of Fintech, its adoption, and how to meet the regulatory challenges for sustaining a Fintech environment that balances the benefits and risks of Fintech.

3. Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by **July 28, 2026** positively. Interested officers are requested to apply online at <https://go.gov.sg/sgqatarfintech2026>

as required by Singapore (Mandatory). **Nomination without online application will not be considered by the host.**

Further, it may be apprised that as per direction of Foreign Training Committee (FTC) of Ministry of Economic Affairs, all officers proceeding on foreign trainings have been directed to submit a 1000-word post-visit report upon return. Accordingly, the officers who are nominated may submit a post visit report to sosea@ead.gov.pk upon return.
