SUBJECT: TRAINING COURSE ON SUPPLY CHAIN RESILIENCE TO BE CONDUCTED IN PERSON IN SINGAPORE FROM 25 TO 29 JANUARY 2027 UNDER THE JAPAN-SINGAPORE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME FOR THE 21ST CENTURY JSPP21

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Governments of Singapore and Japan have invited nominations for the above **Fully Funded** training course. The [brochure](#) of the subject training course is available at www.ead.gov.pk.

2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Government employees (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid-to-senior level government officials who are involved in developing strategies and implementing policies on supply chain resilience for their country;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective

This programme will draw on Singapore's and Japan's experience in economic security and supply chain resilience, examine the impact of recent major events on global supply chains, and explore approaches to strengthening supply chain resilience in an era of geopolitical uncertainty.

3. Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by **October 13, 2026** positively. Interested officers are requested to apply online at <https://go.gov.sg/udtasnv2026> as required by Singapore (Mandatory). Nomination without online application will not be considered by the host.

Further, it may be apprised that on per direction of Foreign Training Committee (FTC) of Ministry of Economic Affairs, all officers proceeding on foreign trainings have been directed to submit a 1000-word post-visit report upon return. Accordingly, the officers who are nominated may submit a post visit report to Section Officer (SEA) upon return.
