- Able to attend **all** the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio;
- Nominated by their respective Governments;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

**Objective**

- This course will focus on Singapore's multi-agency engagement in formulating energy solutions to climate change, achieving a better appreciation of the issues surrounding climate change and the importance of collective mitigating actions taken on a global scale. Participants will also gain an understanding of the types of clean and renewable sources of energy and the related technical principles.


