- Able to attend **all** the e-learning sessions applicants will require on internet-enable devise with Zoom installed, and an internet-enabled devise with functioning webcam, microphone and audio;
- Nominated by their respective Government;
- Proficient in the written and spoken English; and
- In good health.


Objectives:

- This course designed to help deliver on the UNEA sustainable Infrastructure resolutions by increasing the participants ' understanding of opportunities and challenges associated with developing sustainable infrastructure, as well as the policy conditions to enable and Address them. The course will cover links between infrastructure and the Sustainable Development Goal (SDGs), with an emphasis on building resilience, including through integrated approaches and how planners can maximise SDG outcomes by incorporating sustainability concerns into the early strategic planning of infrastructure. This knowledge can then be incorporated into decision making processes.
