Eligibility Criteria

- Mid to senior-level government officials involved in policymaking for climate change, environmental sustainability and energy solutions.
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio.
- Proficient in written and spoken English, and in good health.

Objective

This course will focus on Singapore's multi-agency engagement in formulating energy solutions to climate change, achieving a better appreciation of the issues surrounding climate change and the importance of the collective mitigating actions taken on a global scale. Participants will also gain an understanding of the types of clean and renewable sources of energy and the related technical principles.
