# The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under: **Eligibility Criteria**

- This programme is offered to <u>junior to mid-level officials</u> (two participants from each country) who are involved in earthier one of the following:
- <u>Law Enforcement</u>: law enforcement officials with knowledge and background in counter –terrorism.
- <u>Youth development Officers</u>: Public officials dealing with youth policies and development programmes.
- Youth Leaders: with knowledge and background in:
  - i. Youth programmes and
  - ii. Dealing with issues involving the youth.
- To eligible to apply, applicants of the course are obliged to fulfill the following requirements:
  - i. Must be between the ages of 26-46 years at the announcement of the
  - ii. Must possess a university degree.
  - iii. Fluency in both spoken and written English.

#### **Objective**

- To provide participants with the knowledge and understanding of the psychological make-up and behavioral patterns of youths that are susceptible to terrorism.
- To create awareness among participating countries on the dynamics of youth and terrorism.
- To provide participants with an avenue to exchange views, experience and possible solutions on how best to address the issue and
- To provide the participants with the necessary knowledge to recommend to their respective governments on how to deal with the involvement of youth in terrorism.
